EMS Paramedic Program – Admission Selection Points Worksheet

The EMS Paramedic Program has limited enrollment and a selection process for admission into the program. After all admission eligibility requirements for placement into the selection pool have been satisfied and applicant has applied online for the EMS Paramedic Program, the Paramedic Program uses the following point system for selection into the program. The maximum number of points is 15. We rank applicants according to their total points. Top scorers receive conditional admission in ranking order based on seats available. We place all other applicants on an alternate list in ranking order.
