Before reporting to a Sandburg employee, please ask if he/she is in a position to maintain confidentiality. Employees deemed as 'Responsible Employees' are required to report incidents to the Title IX Coordinator. Responsible employees include all college employees who are not confidential advisors.

If a report is made to the College the survivor has the right to request interim protective measures and accommodations. Carl Sandburg College will provide assistance to implement such measures for survivors including:

1. Changing classes, an on-campus work assignment, transportation or other arrangements related to attendance or employment at the College;
2. Obtaining a campus no contact order; or
3. Ensuring that an order of protection or no contact order entered by a state court will adhered to on campus.

Upon a survivors request the College will provide assistance accessing and navigating campus and local health and mental health services, counseling and advocacy services.
